

Vehicular Edge Treatment Variations




For Working Adjacent To Asphalt-Concrete

- 1. Edge treatment should be as straight as possible to compliment the alignment of paving stones.
- 2. All edge treatment must be vertical to allow a close fit.
- 3. When new concrete is planned adjacent to paving stones, the relief tool should be as small as possible (1/4 inch to allow a close fit.





Relief Tooling



Notes:

Base design section should be by a soils engineer.

All surfacing utilities should be banded in concrete to set stones against.
